HARRY MILLER LOAN FUND

PURPOSE: To provide limited emergency supplemental funds to meet the tuition, book, and living expense costs of Seventh-Day Adventist, International (non-U.S Citizen, non-Resident Alien) students who plan to return to their native countries upon graduation.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. In July of each year, the student Records/Processing/Finance Committee, will review the fund balance of the Miller Loan and determine the amount of funds that will be available for awarding for that academic year.
2. Students needing assistance will complete the application and submit to the office of Financial Aid
3. The Student Records/ Processing/ Finance Committee will review each request in light of the student's:
 - A. Academic performance
 - B. Commitment to return to the native country
 - C. Overall citizenship
 - D. Financial Situation
4. The student will be notified if he/she has been awarded funds and will be requested to go to the Office of Financial Aid to sign the documents. Funds will be credited to the students account after the student has signed the appropriate paperwork. The paperwork will include standard promissory note and a Harry Miller Loan Fund Addendum. Students who return to their native countries will have their award cancelled/amortized at the rate of 20% per year. Those who do not return to their native countries will be required to repay the award with interest as outlined in the addendum.
