Things that EXSEED higher education partners can do:

- Participate in EXSEED Week 2012 – June 18-22.
- Share video lectures, presentations, handouts, and other digital learning objects to be posted in the EXSEED portal.
- Collaborate on developing and implementing student STEM projects for K-12 students during the school year.
- Provide single learning events, workshops, seminars, and classes for STEM teachers and K-12 students either face-to-face or online.
- Collaborate on STEM research, e.g., Telomere Length Project.
- Develop videos on STEM careers and researchers at their institutions – “STEM Rock Stars.” These videos will be posted in the EXSEED portal.
- Repurpose/refurbish usable equipment and distribute to schools where needed.
- Have college/university students adopt a K-12 classroom for monthly Skype sessions to discuss STEM-type activities in their programs, study skills, etc., and to develop a relationship between college/university and the K-12 class.
- Collaborate on developing and contributing to an inter-institutional STEM, non-thesis masters for STEM teachers.
