

Mission Globe Inclusion Criteria

Nearly 10 percent of our alumni and many of our faculty and staff have served abroad. The base of the Mission Globe, located in the middle of the Centennial Pathway, lists all those who meet selected criteria for international service. This includes alumni, faculty and employees of all Loma Linda University Health entities, whether they worked in other countries before or after their study or service at Loma Linda. There is no charge for this listing.

Over time, pictures and stories of these alumni and staff will be added to their listing in the information kiosk database.

Criteria for Inclusion

- Served at least one year cumulatively, including multiple short trips
- Graduate or employee of any Loma Linda University Health entity, including residency programs

Criteria

- Student missionary
- Regular international mission service
- Self supporting/self-employed service internationally
- Indian reservations in the U.S.A., e.g. Monument Valley
- Work for any international church or faith based organization
- International government or company employment
- Citizens of other countries returning home or serving internationally
